You will be enrolled into a current qualification. The AUR20720 – Certificate II in Automotive Vocational Preparation qualification provides a pathway to perform a limited range of tasks related to familiarisation and inspection of mechanical and electrical components and systems of cars, heavy vehicles, outdoor power equipment, bicycles, marine craft and motorcycles. This qualification also covers the skills and knowledge required to perform minor maintenance.


It is important that students commit to all course requirements, including study and assessments the student may need to complete outside their normal training sessions.
