You will be enrolled into a current qualification. 22614VIC – Cert II in Building and Construction (Pre-apprenticeship) This course provides students with the knowledge and skills to enhance their employment prospects in the building and construction industry.

PATHWAYS AND EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITIES

The aim of the 22614VIC Certificate II in Building and Construction (Pre-apprenticeship) is to provide learners with basic industry specific skills and knowledge to enable transition into an apprenticeship within the building and construction industries at the Certificate III level. This pre-apprenticeship course consists of a core of common cross sector units of competency that provide skills and knowledge in:

- applying basic leveling procedures
- carrying out basic measurements and calculations
- communicating in the workplace
- erecting and safely using working platforms
- interpreting basic plans and drawings
- preparing and applying for work in the construction industry
- working effectively and sustainably in the construction industry
- workplace safety practices onsite

After completion of 22614VIC – Cert II in Building and Construction (Pre-apprenticeship) you are eligible to undertake further study in Cert IV Building.
