#### Thursday 31 July – Friday 8 August

- This period is designated for students to thoroughly research and make informed decisions about their pathway and subject choices. During this time, students should:
  - Read through the course handbook
  - Speak with subject teachers, Pastoral Group Leaders and Head of Community about potential subjects
  - Research career pathways related to subjects of interest
  - Submit application forms
  - Discuss options with parents/guardians
  - Schedule careers meetings for personalised guidance
  - Complete their Subject Selection Planning Sheet and discuss this with their parents/carers, Pastoral Group Leader and Head of House.

# Wednesday 6 August

- External VET applications close.
  - Students who wish to apply for an external VET subject must complete an <u>Application to Enrol in External VET</u>. This is to be returned to the Learning and Teaching office for approval. Once approved, students will receive an email advising that the subject has been enabled for selection on the portal. You will not be able to complete selections until this has been approved.

# Monday 11 August – Extended Pastoral Group

- During this extended session, students will complete their subject selections in Pastoral Group with support from their Pastoral Group Leader and Head of House.
- Students must bring their completed planning sheet that has been signed by their Head of House.
- The access link to the Subject Selection Portal will be emailed directly to your student's email address.
- Once they have competed their preferences, you will then receive a link to sign off on the subjects they have selected on the portal.
