#### **Friday 7 August**

- Subject Selection Portal opens
  - The access link will be emailed directly to your student's email address. After discussing subject selection with your child, they can submit their preferences. You will then receive a link to sign off on the subjects they have selected on the portal.

1. Open **Gmail** and sign into your account
