

DUAL QUALIFICATION CERTIFICATE II AND III IN Community Services

You will be enrolled into a current qualification. CHC22015/CHC32015 – Certificate II and III in Community Services reflects the role of entry level Community Services workers who support individuals through the provision of person-centred services. Work may include day-to-day support of individuals in community settings or support the implementation of specific community-based programs. At this level, work takes place under the direction of others and supervision may be direct or indirect. Work may take place in a range of community services organisations.

PATHWAYS AND EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITIES

This qualification provides a pathway to work in Community Services in organisations such as social assistance, disability services and various areas of health care

Job roles vary across different industry sectors and may include:

- Community Work
- Mental Health Work (non clinical)
- Alcohol and Drug services
